UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Breed Booth: The Tacoma show is scheduled for April 2021. We will discuss further in 2021.

New BCGS merchandise (*Aviator Bulldog*): Several sample items were ordered from Teespring and the quality and consistency were poor. Citty Brugalette and Sandy Fisher decided the Club should not use Teespring as a storefront. Other options (CafePress, Zazzle and Redbubble) are currently being looked into.

Ed Trautmann will look into an online store. If the online store does not work out, we will just wait until we can have an in person event and will order merchandise to sell.

Bullycon Merchandise: If anyone would like to purchase a t-shirt or sweatshirt, please contact Sandy Fisher at treasurer@bulldogclubofgreaterseattle.com to place an order. Pricing does not include shipping costs, buyer will need to pay for shipping.

Event Locations: Paws-Abilities has closed so we will need to find a new location for our Halloween Party in 2020. Kent Family Dog (phone call and email were sent, never heard back) was mentioned as a possible venue and other locations should be looked at. Sammamish Valley Grange (\$110 an hour Saturday; \$75 an hour Sunday – 3 hour minimum), Cascade Kennels were also mentioned and need follow ups. It was discussed that as a last resort, we could have the Halloween party at Win-Star Bed & Biscuit (where the Christmas party is held). Sammamish Valley Grange does not offer a special price for non-profits.

Junior Handlers: Dave is looking for suggestions on how to promote this. AKC has a survey out regarding Junior Participation in the Sport (only 1 survey response per Club). Does anyone know of any 4H groups? Members can send the 4H groups a letter stating they have a dog(s) available. Dog needs to be co-owned with a junior.

Specialty January 2021 (Puyallup): Jeff Ryman asked Dave if BCGS would be interested in holding a specialty show in conjunction with the all-breed and French Bulldog Specialty in January 2021 in Puyallup. BCGS would have to split the fee for Baray and the judge. BCGS would need a ring steward. Joan Johnson spoke to Yolanda with AKC and confirmed we can host a generic show in January without it affecting our specialty show in July/August. The Club has decided to move forward with this event. Dave Harrington is getting this scheduled.

- ➤ Puyallup Kennel club has approved us for the show. They also have asked that we do it Friday afternoon. If we want to do a sweeps they suggest that we do sweeps while Adrian is judging the French bulldogs.
- ➤ BCGS needs to send a letter to the AKC asking for approval. Dave Harrington will ask Jeff Ryman for a copy of the letter he used.

- ➤ BCGS needs someone that is not showing to *either* pick the Judge up from the airport Thursday night or bring him back Saturday. We only need one or the other. Do we want to split the cost of an Uber with the French Bulldog Club?
- Need approval for a judge's gift \$100 Amazon card. Approved.
- ➤ Need a judge for sweeps. Dave Harrington to reach out to Leta Graham.

- Patricia Whitney will ask her daughter if she can be our ring steward.
- ➤ Dave Harrington will find out what our deadline is to get everything done.

NEW BUSINESS:

Rose City/Specialty 2021 Show: Rose City has cancelled their January 2021 show and is potentially rescheduling it to the last weekend of July 2021 which is when the BCGS Specialty is scheduled. Citty Brugalette spoke to Patti Strand who is the Rose City show chair. They are not yet confirmed for the last weekend in July yet as they are trying to work with some other Clubs to get a cluster going. There is also a possibility where they would start earlier and end on either 7/28 or 7/29. Patti advised that they should have a decision made within the next 2 weeks. It was also discussed with Patti that BCGS would possibly do a supported entry for Rose City. Should BCGS do this, we would need to notify and get permission from OSBC as BCGS is outside of its assigned area. Citty Brugalette will follow up with Patti in 2 weeks. The Hotel RL Olympia is holding the first weekend of August for BCGS should we want to switch weekends.

- ➤ BCGS prior Specialty Shows have always been in August. A motion was made and approved to move the 2021 and 2022 shows to the first weekend of August. Citty Brugalette will confirm these changes with the hotel and get revised contracts signed.
- ➤ Joan Johnson will discuss BCGS doing a supported entry at Rose City at the next Division V meeting on November 1, 2020.
